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Classes on Mondays 17:00-18:30

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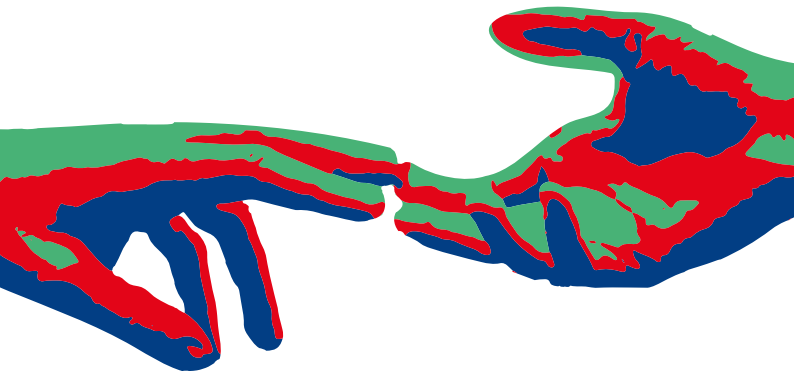
