#### **From Philosophical Shakespeare to Unpredictable Potter: A Literary Survey**

The seminar's primary goal is to support students in writing the BA theses on topics of their choice and to monitor their progress. The main components of the seminar:

- the research on critical approaches
- the analysis and interpretation of English literature texts (prose, poems, songs, etc) connected directly and indirectly with works selected by students
- the general research and selection of academic sources (taking notes, selecting quotations, implementing new information in the BA thesis, etc.)
- the development of various components of the BA thesis, such as the title, table of contents, introduction, main body, and conclusion
- the preparation of initial drafts of the thesis (during the classes).

Requirements: active participation (writing, commenting on other students' work, etc.), presentations about selected BA topics, attendance (two "unexcused" absences per term).

#### **BA Seminar in Applied Linguistics**

This BA seminar is dedicated to students who want to broaden their knowledge and skills in linguistic research. During the seminar, students will have a chance to explore issues related to morphology, semantics, pragmatics, sociolinguistics (esp. pidgins and creoles, World Englishes) and English for Specific Purposes. The main goal of the class is to develop students' research competence by working with real linguistic data. An integral part of this course will be learning how to use corpus software (e.g. AntConc). The class is tailored to those with no prior experience in corpus linguistics, meaning that no introductory knowledge of the field is required.
